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Executive Summary

Strengths of FSU Graduate Programs

- 96% of respondents classified their level of preparation as excellent, good, or adequate.
- 91% of respondents would recommend FSU to other potential students.
- **93**% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU has brought them closer to achieving their goals.
- **89%** of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate experience at FSU was rewarding.
- 89% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU is marketable
- 90% of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with faculty expertise.
- **90%** of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with the quality of instruction in their courses.
- **89%** of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with feedback they received in courses from faculty.

Areas of concern

- 73% of respondents indicated that work or financial obligations were extremely challenging or challenging.
- **60%** of respondents indicated that course requirements and coursework were extremely challenging or challenging.
- **58%** of respondents indicated that the comprehensive exam was extremely challenging or challenging.





Did you receive your undergraduate degree from FSU?





Would you recommend FSU to other potential students?



What was your zip code while attending FSU as a graduate student?


