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Executive Summary

Strengths of FSU Graduate Programs

- 96% of respondents classified their level of preparation as excellent, good, or adequate.
- **93%** of respondents would recommend FSU to other potential students.
- **88%** of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU has brought them closer to achieving their goals.
- 83% of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with faculty expertise.
- **86%** of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with the program coverage of relevant content
- **79%** of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU is marketable.
- **77%** of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with finding and working with their graduate program coordinator
- **82%** of respondents indicated that they were very satisfied or satisfied with the accessibility of instructors
- **88%** of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate experience at FSU was rewarding.

Areas of concern

- **61%** of respondents indicated that work or financial obligations were extremely challenging or challenging.
- **70%** of respondents indicated that communication with their graduate advisor was extremely challenging or challenging.
- **69%** of respondents indicated that communication with faculty was extremely challenging or challenging.
- **69%** of respondents indicated that communication with the graduate office staff was extremely challenging or challenging.


How applicable were the program requirements to your current/or future workplace?




## Did you receive your undergraduate degree from FSU?



### Would you recommend FSU to other potential students?





# Are you an in-state, out-of-state, or international student (living inside or outside the U.S.)?




