



Application Process for Sociology and Criminology Majors

Students wishing to become sociology or criminology majors must complete a major information sheet and a change of major form (obtained at the Registrar's office). If you are switching to sociology or criminology from another major, the chair of your current department must sign the change of major form. If you are currently undeclared, Dr. Chris Gregory (CASA) must sign the change of major form. Once you have completed the change of major form and the major information sheet, you should arrange for the Registrar's office to send the chair of the sociology department a copy of your undergraduate transcript. This does not need to be an "official transcript," but it must come directly from the Registrar's office to the sociology chair. You must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 to be accepted into either major. We strongly encourage you to complete this process at the beginning of the fall or spring semester, although applications will be accepted throughout the academic year.

Please leave your change of major form with the sociology department chair, Dr. Sue Dargan, in Crocker 201. If Dr. Dargan is not in her office please leave the forms in the box outside of her door. She will contact you via E-mail when she has received your transcript to arrange for your transfer into the major. Please make sure that you provide her with your FSU E-mail address and check that E-mail account regularly.
