## **Calculus I: History of Math Paper Guidelines**

You are to write a 1-2 page double spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font, paper on the history and origins of Calculus. Title page, references page, graphs, pictures, etcetera do not count toward the page length requirement. General guiding questions to help you write your paper are the following:

1) What are some old problems of mathematics that led to the formalization of Calculus?

2) Who is responsible for developing Calculus?

3) How does the idea of limits contribute to the discipline of Calculus?

4) In your opinion, was Calculus created or discovered?
