




### Question 12: After completing your graduate program, how would you classify your level of preparation?








Question 16: Did you receive your undergraduate degree from FSU?




## Question 17: Would you select FSU if you were to begin graduate school all over again?




Question 18: Would you recommend FSU to other potential students?

### Question 19: Would you recommend canceling or waiving the GRE or GMAT exam from the list of admission requirements?




