The rubrics have just been accepted by the department this month. Dr. Laura Lamontagne and Dr. Lori Lavigne will both be assessing Learning objective #1 and Learning Objective #2 from the assignments from Spring 2018 and Spring 2019 (when available). By using two faculty to assess, we will both review our rubric scores and see how much of a difference we have between our scores. Depending on our differences, we will either report both or use an average of our scores.
