Every internship reports have been reviewed and graded by a committee of reviewers, assuring all the program PLOs meet or exceeds expectations toward the capstone level.
(3) The improvement on the student learnings were confirmed and validated with faculty members in the Leadership course. According to the faculty instructors from the course evaluated, greater than 92% of students have meet all the expected requirement on the PLOs including Ethical Decision; based on students' performance in case studies, class presentations, team projects, weekly assignment and class discussion.
