Luce Aubry, Bruce Bucci and Nozomi Tomita looked at how the True Way ASL (TWA) published curriculum aligns with the Performance Descriptors for Language Learners of the American Council of Teachers of Foreign Languages to determine if we are on track to meet PLO 1 which states: 'Graduating students should be able to communicate in their working languages (American Sign Language and English) at a level equivalent to Advanced High in speaking and listening as established by ACTFL.' Luce Aubry developed a map that showed which units of TWA aligned with the ACTFL descriptors (attached). Early in the fall 2021 semester, classroom observations of ASGN 201 and 301 revealed that the material covered in class at these levels did not meet the ACTFL outcomes for these intermediate and advanced levels. Program faculty are now in the process of adding to the TWA materials this semester because students have already purchased the material. However we are considering replacing or adding to the TWA curriculum in future semesters. We will also be submitting a personnel request to create a lab instructor position to supplement classroom instruction. We are envisioning that the lab instructor will provide supplemental instruction to students outside of class time. This supplemental instruction will allow students more time-on-task while also giving them opportunities for authentic conversational practice outside of the classroom.
