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Executive Summary

Strengths of FSU Graduate Programs

- 99% of respondents classified their level of preparation as excellent, good, or adequate.
- 97% of respondents would recommend FSU to other potential students.
- **91%** of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU has brought them closer to achieving their goals.
- 91% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate experience at FSU was rewarding.
- 86% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that their graduate degree from FSU is marketable.
- **91%** of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with length of graduate program.
- 87% of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with accessibility of instructors.
- 86% of respondents indicated they were very satisfied or satisfied with program coverage of relevant content.

Areas of Concern

- 47% of respondents indicated that course requirements and coursework were extremely challenging or challenging.
- **45**% of respondents indicated that work or financial obligations were extremely challenging or challenging.

Qualitative Analysis

Below is a summary of the qualitative data. Responses are at the end of the survey.

Strengths of FSU Graduate Programs

- Flexibility, convenience, and quality of program.
- Faculty were knowledgeable and supportive.
- Faculty and staff effectively communicated with students.
- Cost and location.

Ways to make the FSU graduate studies more attractive

- Increase the variety and offering of courses.
- Increase advertising for the graduate programs.
- Assist students in receiving teaching licensure or certification.
- Ensure course content is challenging and relevant to international students.

Items FSU could do better to meet the needs of alumni, current students, or future students

- Improve communication with advisors, administration, and faculty.
- Increase the availability and flexibility of courses.
- Improve alumni networking.
- Provide students with post-graduation job placement/career services.







Did you receive your undergraduate degree from FSU?





Would you select FSU if you were to begin graduate school all over again?




