STEM is in demand, specifically biotech and especially in the Eastern Massachusetts/Greater Boston area. I now make 100k USD a year in biotech since graduating [redacted]. With my bachelor's from FSU, as well as my associate's of science from [redacted], which is also in [redacted], I have hopped from multiple jobs and asked for more money each time. I got a job within a couple weeks of finishing my bachelor's of science at FSU. I have changed jobs four times in the past year, until I was making 50 USD an hour, about 100k USD a year. I owe it all to my education and my willingness to hustle with job recruiters etc. I am very grateful to FSU, [redacted], and to the STEM programs in all state schools. I am very satisfied and grateful.
