#### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS (5 Courses)

\*\* Goal 1 (Writing) and Goal 2 (Quantitative) must be completed within the first year of matriculating at the university. In conformity with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and in partial fulfillment of the mission of the State Universities to prepare informed citizens, all students at Framingham State University must take course meeting either general education goal eight (8) or goal ten (10) in which both the United States and Massachusetts constitutions are studied. In addition, at least one course taken under Goal 6 (Physical Science) or Goal 7 (Life Science) must be a laboratory course. Courses that include a laboratory or study of the constitutions are identified in the listing.
