## MINOR IN ENVIRONTMENTAL STUDIES AND SOCIAL JUSTICE (5 Courses)

The minor in Environmental Studies and Social Justice is designed to provide undergraduate students with a structured program highlighting the interdisciplinary study of the environment with an emphasis on environmental justice. To fulfill the minor requirements, students must complete three required courses and two elective courses.

## Notes:

- Courses in the minor may also be used to fulfill General Education (Gen. Ed.) requirements (see notation following course title). Depending on a student's major some Gen. Eds. may already be fulfilled.
- A minimum of three (3) course-credits (12 semester hours) in the minor must be completed at Framingham State University to meet the residency requirement.
