Requirements to begin Field Study I/II and Student Teaching:

Applications for Field Study I/II and Student Teaching: Must be submitted (DH302) prior to February 15th for the next fall semester and October 1st for the next spring semester.

Course Requirements: Both EDUC 200 and PSYC 200 must be completed prior to EDUC 315/316 with Field Study II.

MTEL Exams:

May at end of Year Two: MTEL (01) *Communication and Literacy Skills Test 1*; must pass prior to Field Study II
 September Year Three: MTEL (06) *History*; must pass prior to Student Teaching

GPA Requirements: Students with a Secondary Education minor must maintain a minimum of **2.80 GPA** in all education courses (EDUC) and Psychology of Development (PSYC 200), and as a cumulative overall GPA in all courses taken at Framingham State University. **History major / Secondary Ed minor students must maintain a minimum of 3.0 GPA in their UHIT concentration courses to be considered for Field Study II and Pro Prep.**
