**GPA Requirements:** Students with a Secondary Education minor must maintain a minimum of **2.80 GPA** in all education courses (EDUC) and Psychology of Development (PSYC 200), and as a cumulative overall GPA in all courses taken at Framingham State University. **History major / Secondary Ed minor students must maintain a minimum of <b>3.0 GPA in their UHIT concentration courses to be considered for Field Study II and Pro Prep.**
