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Examples of Full-time Students' Tuition*

15 hours = 2 morning courses	\$1,520
18 hours = 2 morning courses and 1 afternoon focus course	\$1,790
20 hours = 2 morning courses and Transitions course	\$1,855
21 hours = 2 morning courses and 2 afternoon focus courses	\$2,060
15 hours + Individualized Study Plan (6 hours)	\$1,940

* F-1 visa students must enroll for at least 18 hours of study per week.

*Students with no prior English instruction should include an Individualized Study Plan with their other courses.
