-- Domain General Education courses and open electives may be taken in any semester and in any order, except for Common Core Domain requirements, which must be taken during Year One.

-- ENGL 204 Literary Study should be completed as early as possible in the student's program. It is the prerequisite for all 300-level literature courses.

-- The Department recommends that a majority of English courses elected in the Junior and Senior years be at the 300- and 400-level.
