Interdepartmental major

- Domain General Education courses and open electives may be taken in any semester and in any order, except for Common Core Domain requirements, which must be taken during Year One.
- Students must take at least one (1) semester of Study Abroad. It is strongly recommended that the study abroad be taken during junior year, either fall or spring semester. Under exceptional circumstances a student may opt to conduct an intensive internship program within the United States at an appropriate organization.
