IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 508-626-4911 (OR 4911 FROM A UNIVERSITY PHONE)



FIRE / FIRE ALARM

- Evacuate the building immediately: Activate pull station by door if needed
- DO NOT use the elevators
- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone)

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone)
- Identify your location, nature of the injury and how many injured or ill
- Stay on the phone with the Police
- If certified in First Aid and/or CPR, begin administration



ARMED PERSON(S)

- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone) if safe to do so
- RUN Try to escape or evacuate to a safe area, then call police
- HIDE Secure your hiding place, shut lights, lock doors, silence cell phones and text* the police
- FIGHT This is a last resort and only if your life is in danger. Call the police when safe to do so
 - * If unable to speak, contact the police by sending a text message to the number 67283. In the text message pane, type FSUTIP, followed by a space, and then your message.

- **CHEMICAL EXPOSURE/ACCIDENT** DO NOT handle hazardous materials
- unless you are trained to do so
- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone)

GAS LEAK / FUMES / VAPORS

- DO NOT pull fire alarms
- DO NOT touch light switches or electrical • equipment
- Evacuate the area immediately
- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone) from a safe distance

BOMB / SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE

- DO NOT touch or try to move the device
- Evacuate the immediate area
- Call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone) from a safe distance

BLOOD / BODILY FLUIDS

If there is a significant blood spill (more than few drops), call 508-626-4911 (or 4911 from a University phone) and complete an online maintenance request form

LOCKDOWN VS. SHELTER IN PLACE

Instructions may be given by the police to either Lockdown or Shelter in Place. Please be aware of the differences:

- When a **LOCKDOWN** order is given, occupants of the University are directed to remain confined to a room/area with specific procedures to follow regarding locking of doors, closing of window shades and seeking cover.
- When a SHELTER IN PLACE order is given, occupants are to remain inside of University buildings to keep them from being exposed to the elements or incident that may be occurring else where. Occupants are free to move around/within the building, but should not exit until informed via updated instructions or via a uniformed police officer.
