Shin, a Fulbright Scholar to China, examines how she balanced her teaching responsibilities with students, time with fellow Chinese colleagues, and cultural expectations in daily life in China. Her 2019 book, *Narrative Inquiries from Fulbright Lecturers in China: Cross-Cultural Connections to Higher Education*, is a roadmap for negotiating China's higher education network and cross-cultural educational environment.
