## The Basics

### PERSONAL ITEMS

1. Medicine/prescriptions
2. Medical insurance card
3. First-aid kit
4. Thermometer
5. Photo ID (license, passport, state ID, etc.)
6. Hangers
7. Clothes
8. Shower shoes
9. Bathroom caddy
10. Toiletries/soap/towels
11. Laundry detergent
12. Dish soap

### DECOR

1. Linens

2. Pillow
3. Desk lamp
4. Portable fan
5. Posters
6. Non-staining poster-putty or removable squares

### CLASS SUPPLIES

1. Backpack
2. Pens/Pencils
3. Portable hand sanitizer
4. Tape/Stapler
5. Books

### TECH/GADGETS

1. Cell phone/charger
2. Head phones/earbuds
3. Laptop/accessories
4. TV (No bigger than 40")
5. Box Fan
6. Desk lamp
7. Surge protector (UL approved)
8. Mini-refrigerator (1 per room; 3.1 cubic feet or less, energy star certified)

### MISCELLANEOUS

1. Plastic storage bins
2. Sewing kit
3. Rain coat/umbrella
4. Plates, bowls, cups and utensils
5. Reusable water bottle
6. Laundry Basket
7. Cleaning supplies, wet mop/ broom.

## Do NOT Bring

- Pets
- Extension cords (except 3-prong surge protectors)
- Candles/incense/fireworks
- Microwave
- Duct tape, nails, or screws
- Space heaters
- Amplifiers
- Drums/amplified instruments
- Halogen lamps
- Cooking appliances
- Knives
- Cinder blocks
- Paint
- Bulletin boards
- Cushioned furniture
- Weapons/replica weapons
- Airsoft/Orbeez or similar "toy" guns
- Marijuana
- Illicit drugs/drug paraphernalia
- Alcohol/alcohol containers
