Introducing the MWRTA's Catch Connect! On-demand micro transit Framingham and Natick service

What is Catch Connect? Catch Connect is an on-demand micro-transit service offered by the MetroWest Regional Transit Authority (MWRTA) which allows you to go where you want when you want (within the service area and hours of operation). The trained, professional, and courteous drivers will take you where you need to go, while the Catch Connect app will allow you to track your vehicles, receiving real-time updates on your trip in progress.

Hours of Operation are: Monday -Friday 7:30 pm-10:00 pm  
Saturday and Sunday 8:00 am-6:00 pm



**\*\*This service will not operate on major Holidays\*\***

**This is a free service for all current FSU students. You must use your FSU student email address to register for the free trips.** This service is on a first come first serve basis. Trips booked near the end of the day could be canceled if the trips are queue past 6 pm. Trips after 6 pm will be covered by FSU weekend Ram Tram service.

Here's how to book:

After downloading the Catch App and registering using your FSU student email address, visit the "Connect" tab on the app. Tap where it says "Current Location" and enter the address of your location (FSU 100 State Street). Underneath, tap where it says "Where would you like to go?" and enter the destination of your trip you may also enter key names such as "Target or "Natick Mall", and click on the location that pops up. Confirm that both addresses shown are correct, and then click the book button. Follow the same instructions when returning to campus.

Scan the QR codes with your phone to download the app.



Pick up and drop off location will be in front of the McCarthy Center at the MWRTA bus stop
