

MINOR IN IRISH STUDIES (5 Courses)

Notes:

- *Courses in the minor may also be used to fulfill General Education (Gen. Ed.) requirements (see notation following course title). Depending on a student's major some Gen. Eds. may already be fulfilled.*
- *A minimum of three (3) course-credits (12 semester hours) in the minor must be completed at Framingham State University to meet the residency requirement. Exceptions to the University's Course Residency requirement may be made by the Chair of the English Department in conjunction with the University Registrar.*

To earn an Irish Studies minor, students must apply in writing to the Chair of the English Department. Minor may include up to three (3) courses in Irish studies taken abroad at the University of Ulster, subject to approval by the Chair of the English Department. Only one (1) course may be taken within the student's major subject area.
