

MINOR IN MEDIA, CULTURE, AND SOCIETY (5 Courses)

Notes:

- *Courses in the minor may also be used to fulfill General Education (Gen. Ed.) requirements (see notation following course title). Depending on a student's major some Gen. Eds. may already be fulfilled.*
- *A minimum of three (3) course-credits (12 semester hours) in the minor must be completed at Framingham State University to meet the residency requirement.*

The Media, Culture, and Society minor offers students the opportunity to explore the intimate connection between media platforms and institutions on the one hand, and society and culture on the other. The minor requires that students take a minimum of four (4) courses outside of their major subject area. Only one (1) course may be taken within the student's major subject area.
