In 2009, Framingham State University received a very generous gift designed to support the teaching of STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) in our schools. Over the past five years we were able to award several scholarships to students in our STEM programs. **Students in the following programs may be eligible to apply for this scholarship: M.Ed. with a concentration in Curriculum and Instructional Technology, M.Ed. with a concentration in Educational Technology, M.Ed. with a concentration in Mathematics, M.Ed. with a concentration in Secondary Education, Mathematics, M.Ed. with a concentration in STEM Education, PBTL Biology, PBTL Chemistry, PBTL Earth Sciences and PBTL Math.** Please note that you may apply for this scholarship each year that it is offered while you are pursuing your degree or PBTL completion.

The following restrictions apply to students seeking this scholarship:

- Recipients must be currently teaching a STEM subject.
- Recipients may use the financial aid for up to two classes per semester.
- Recipients must sustain a GPA of 3.5 or greater.
- If a student fails to return to school at Framingham State University, does not complete both semesters of the academic year, or does not meet the criteria, the remaining scholarship may be awarded immediately to a deserving student following the above criteria.
